Christ: the Way, the Truth and the Life

- **1. The Creed: Summary of our Faith in Jesus Christ**
God's revelation of himself (the history of salvation), and our response to his invitation (we believe). The four dimensions of the Christian life. The language of faith.
- **2. The Mystery of Christ and the Holy Trinity**
Who is God, One and Triune? What does it mean to say that he is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit? How do I share this with others?
- **3. The Mystery of the Church of Christ**
The Church is a plan born in the Father's heart. What does the Church teach? Mary as a 'type' of the Church. The Communion of Saints.

Sources of the Faith

- **4. Introduction to Sacred Scripture**
Reading Sacred Scripture with the mind of the Church, and as a place of encounter with the eternal Word. An exploration of the unity of the Old and New Testaments - the one word of God.
- **5. Introduction to the Liturgy**
What do we mean by 'liturgy', the work of the Holy Trinity? Sacred Scripture in the Liturgy. Praying the Liturgy. The Catechumenal model in light of the new Directory for Catechesis.
- **6. Introduction to the Sacraments**
What do we mean by 'Sacrament'? Exploring all seven Sacraments with a particular focus on the Sacraments of Initiation.

- **7. Grace and the Theological Virtues**
In the light of the recent teaching by Pope Benedict XVI and Pope Francis, how do we use these for mission to foster faith, hope and love?
- **8. The Dignity of the Human Person**
Created in the image of God, we are called to share in everlasting happiness with him in heaven. A look at our intrinsic dignity; the morality of happiness; what do goodness, freedom and responsibility mean; and what we are made for - everlasting happiness.
- **9. Life in Christ**
Catholic moral teaching in the light of our call to happiness and eternal life with God and the grace of Christ, through the gifts of the Holy Spirit. How to share this with others.

- **10. Sacred Art and the New Evangelisation**
A beautiful exploration of the language of sacred art and how it can help us to share the faith with others.
- **11. Media and the New Evangelisation**

- **12. The Parish and the New Evangelisation**
Priest, Prophet and King: how do we respond to the call to holiness? The Four Dimension of the Faith in the context of parish life, including the importance of the Domestic Church. What does authentic lay collaboration with the ministerial priesthood look like?
