- 5. How easy or hard do you find reaching out to others and inviting them to anything faith-related?
- 6. What is the mindset we want to have toward those who are not in church?
- 7. What would help you grow in confidence to speak more freely about faith with strangers?
- 8. What could be a next step for your parish to understand evangelisation better and come up with a tangible way of implementing an inviting environment with practical options?
- 9. Where is your heart at concerning evangelisation?
- 10. How do you understand the relationship between prayer and evangelisation activity?
