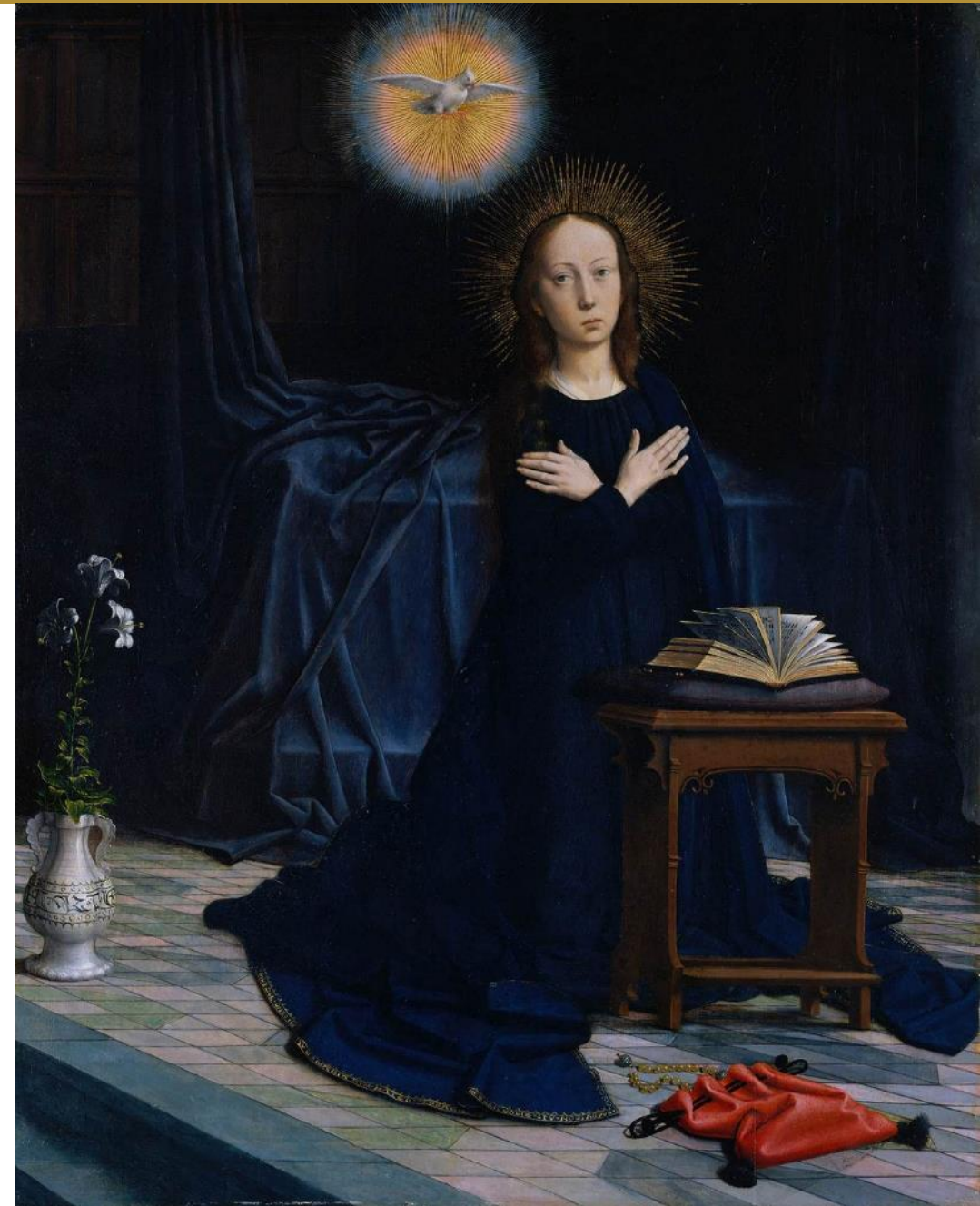

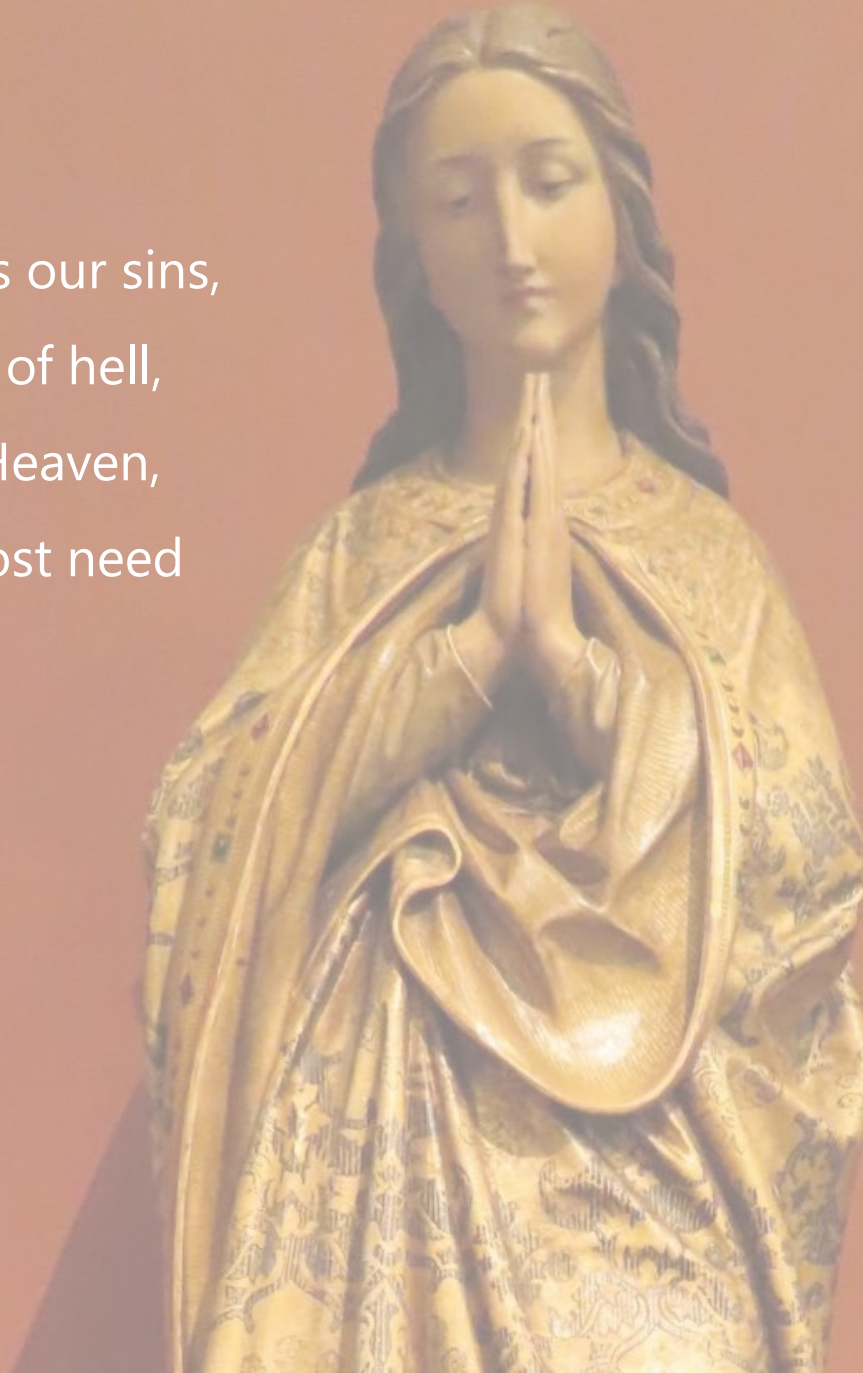




## **The Fatima Prayer**
