but in order that the world might be saved through him.*

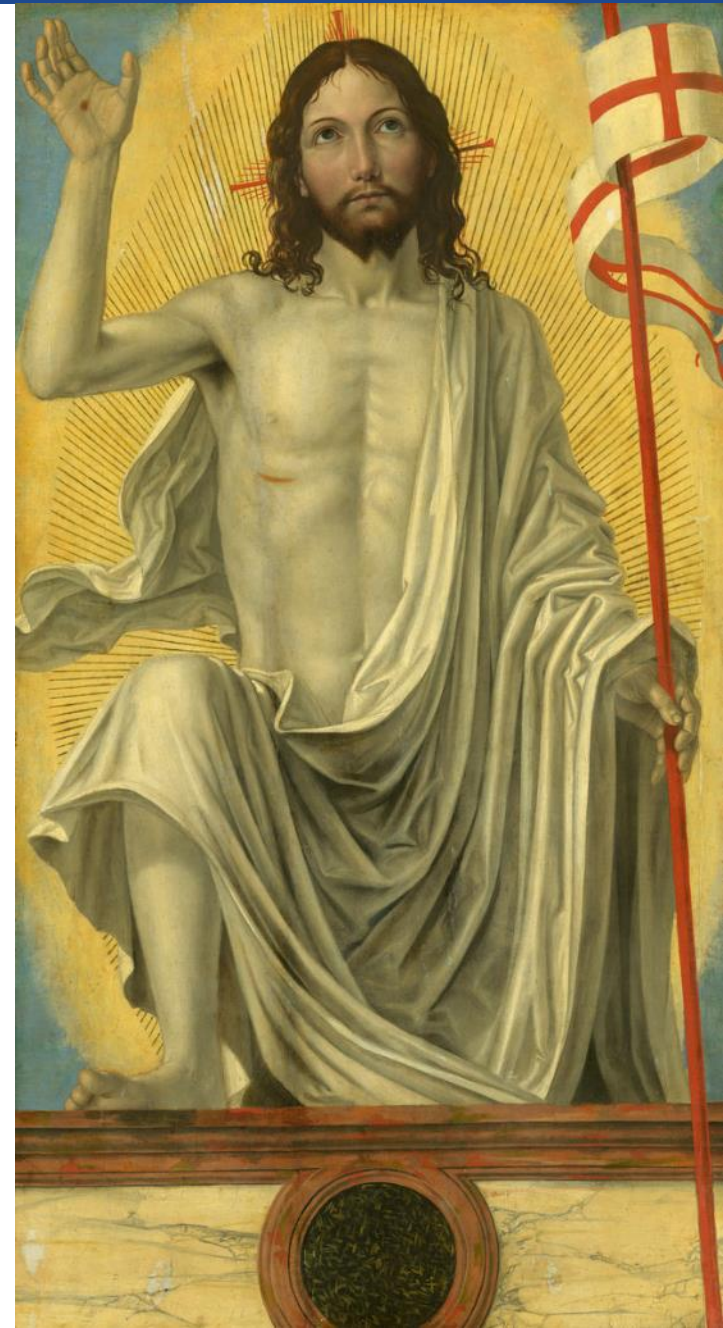

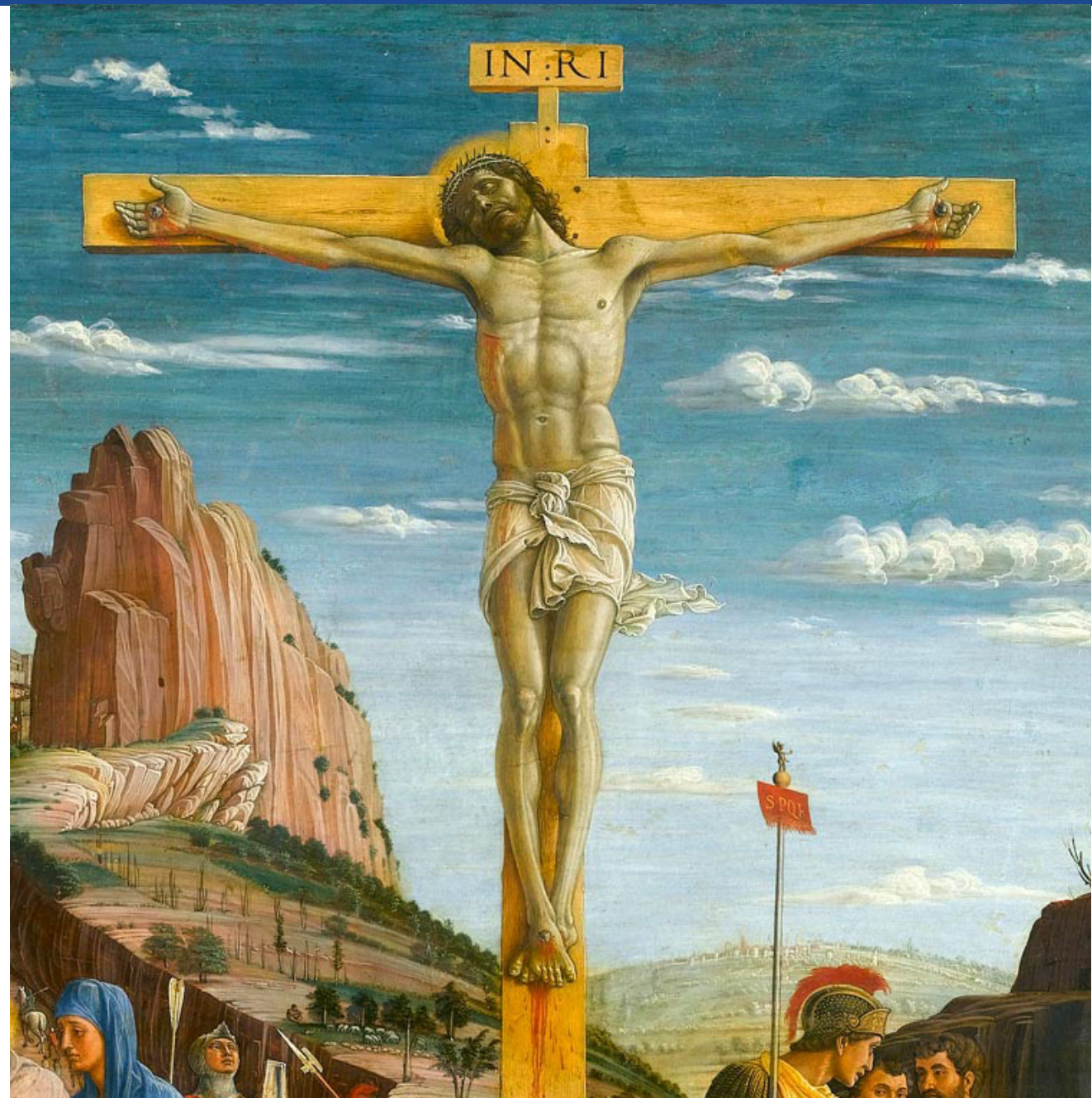
