

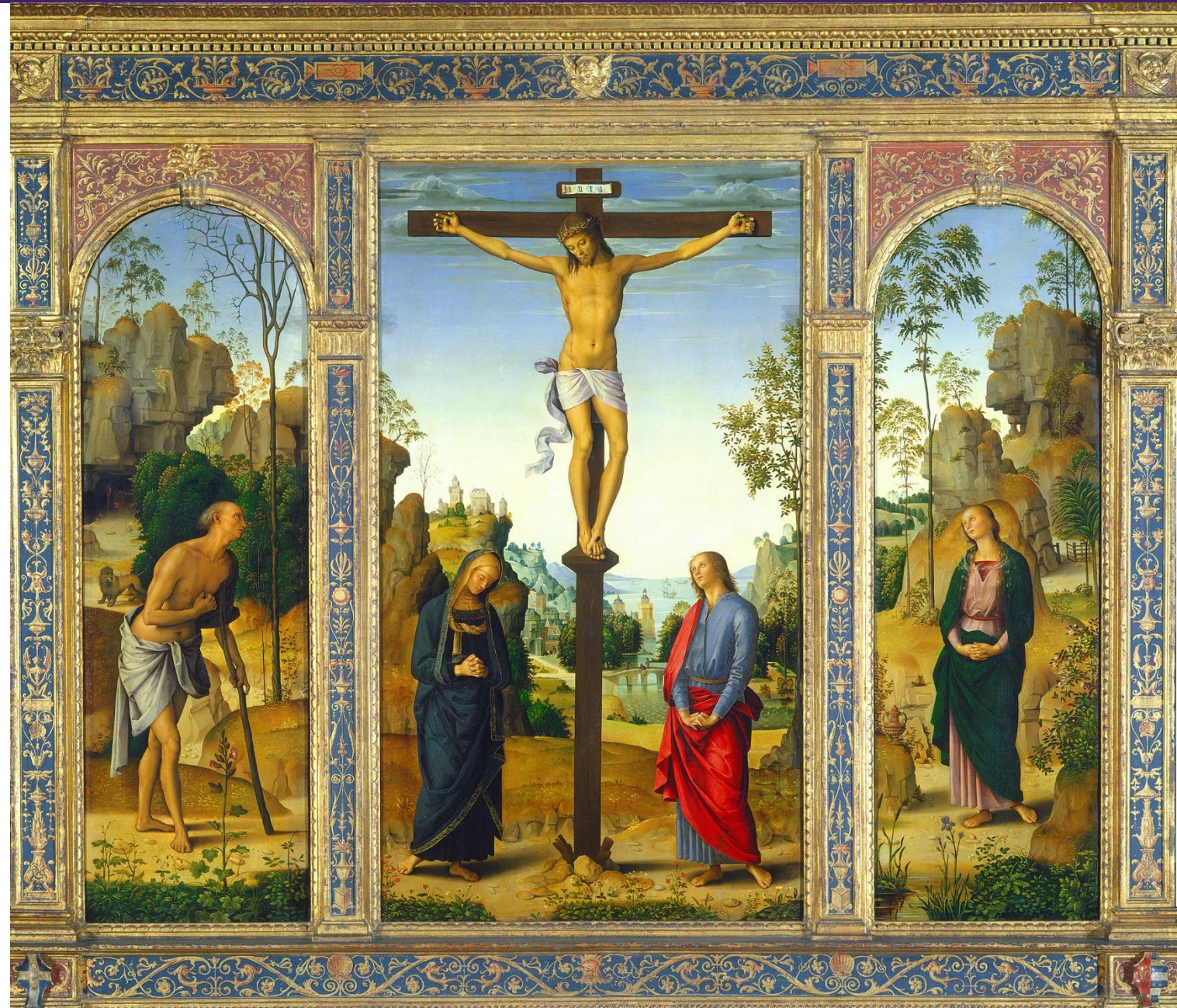

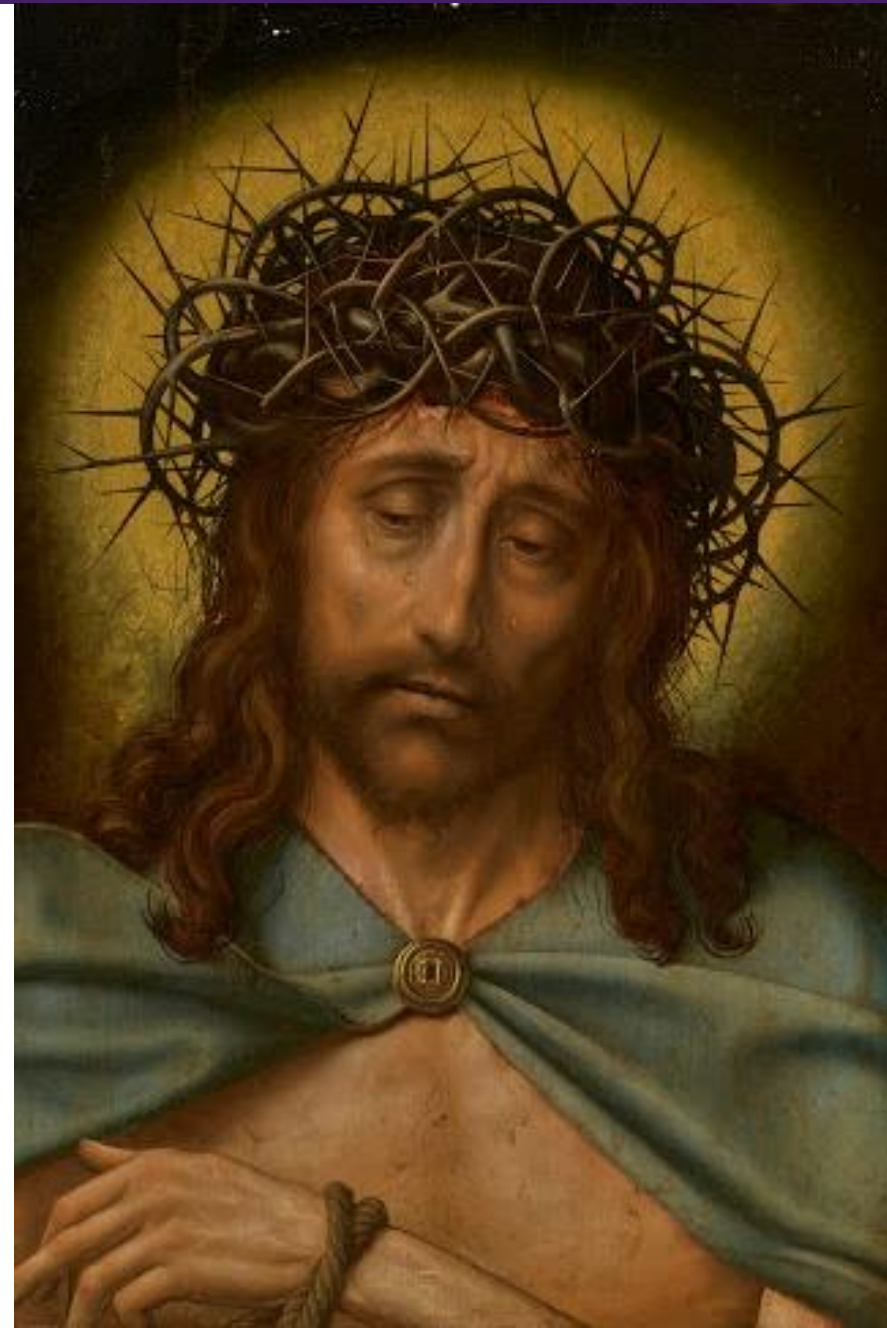

Then the soldiers of the governor took Jesus into the governor's headquarters, and they gathered the whole battalion before him.

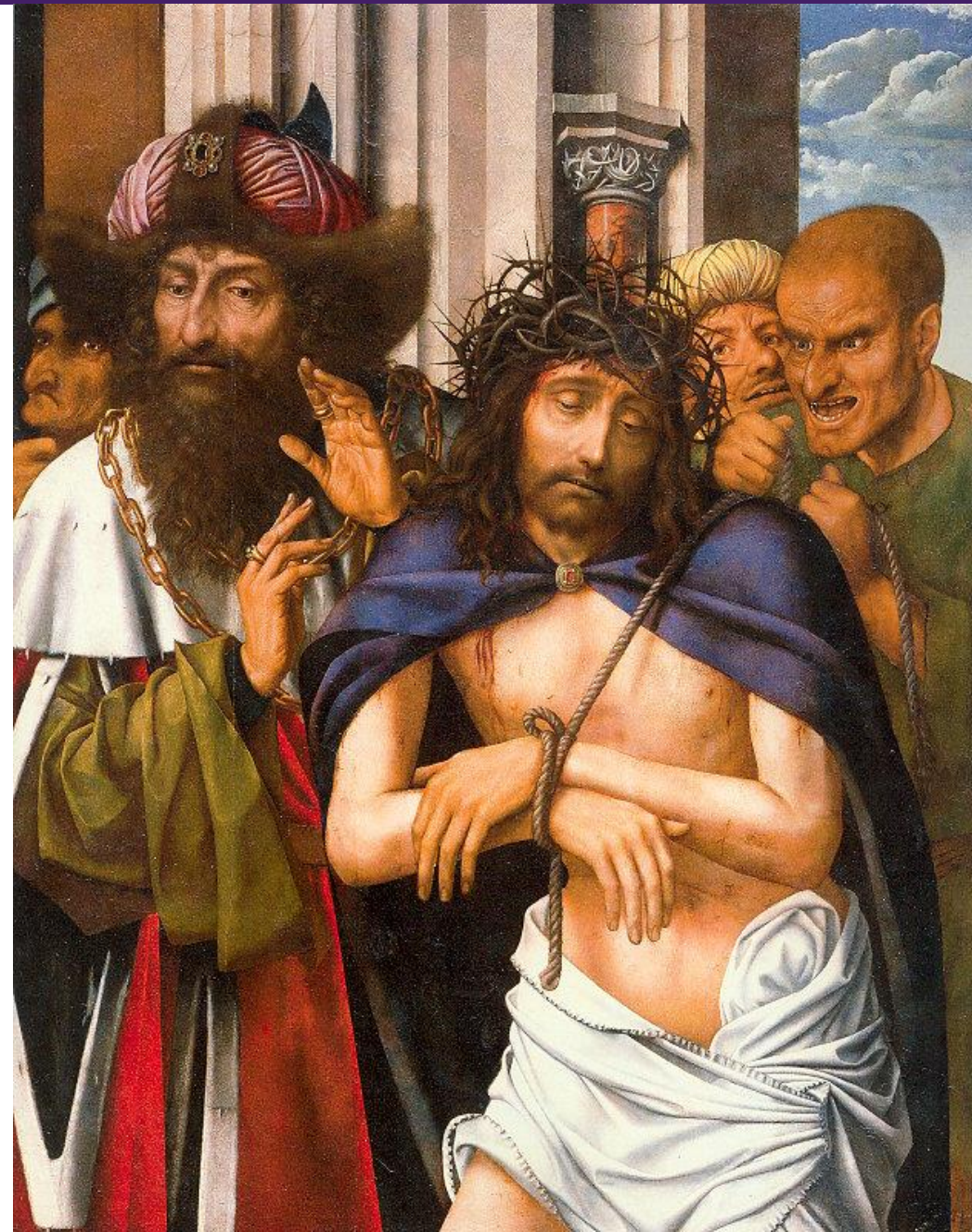

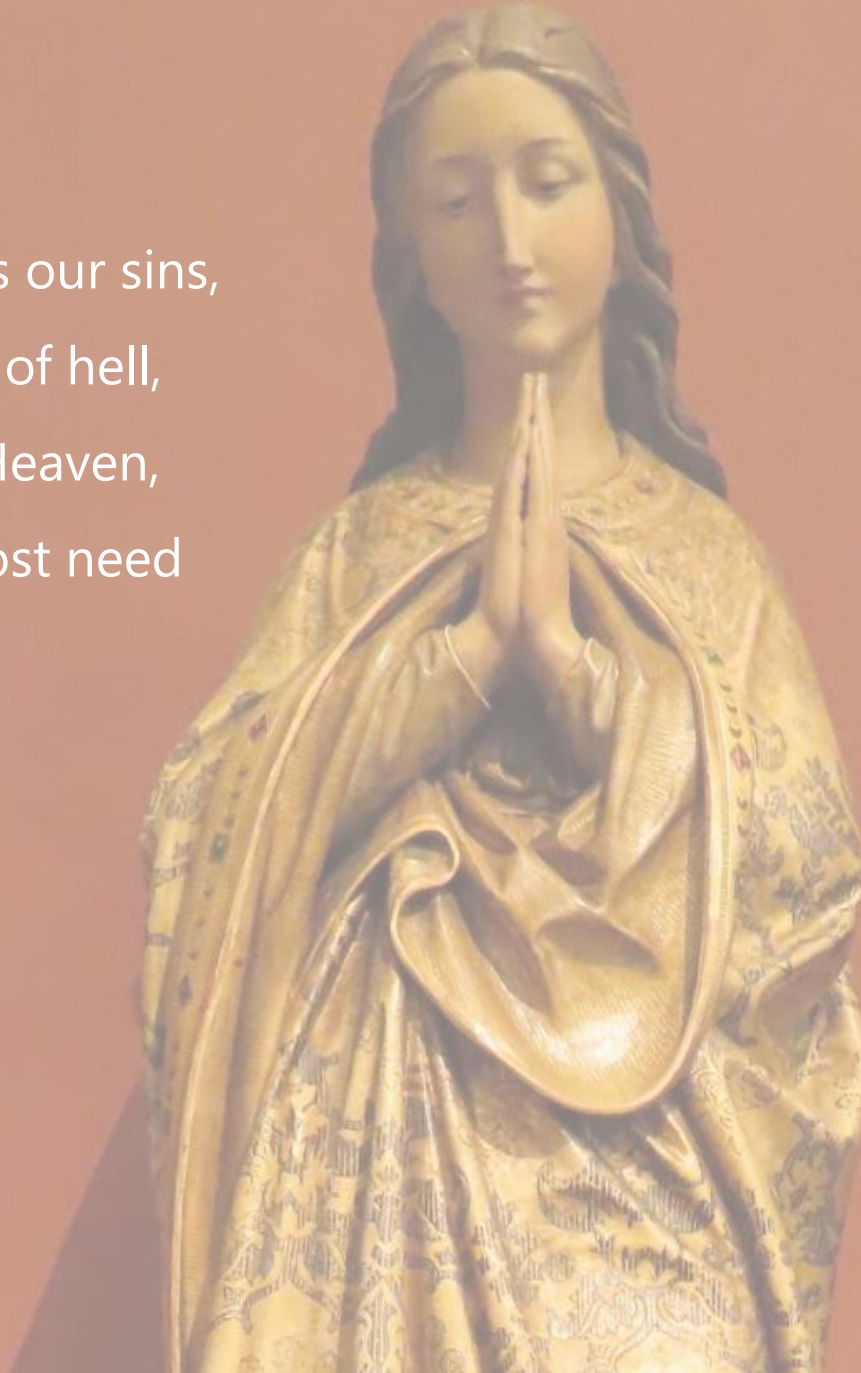
