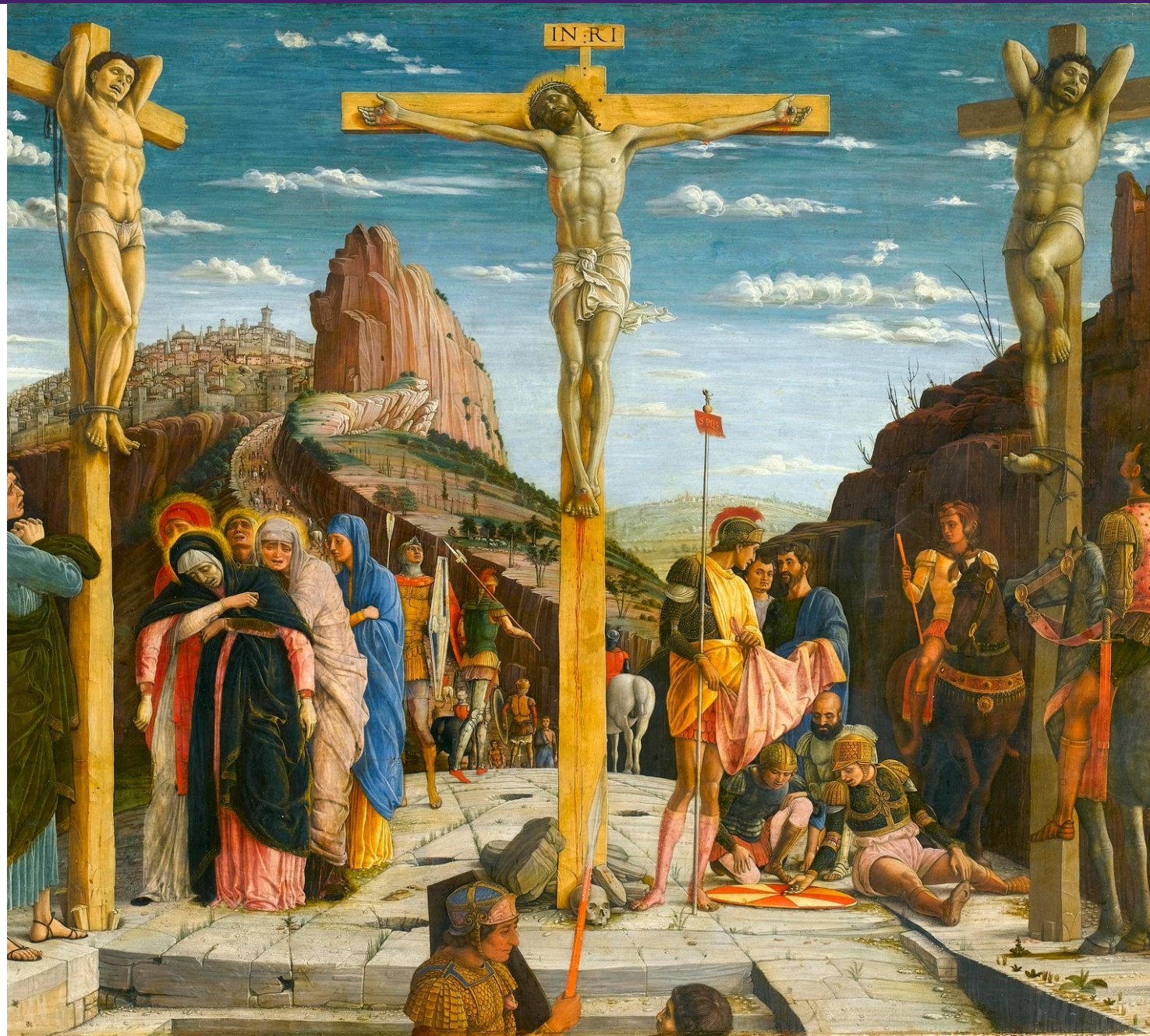
And when they came to the place that is called The Skull, there they crucified him, and the criminals, one on his right and one on his left.

'My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?'*

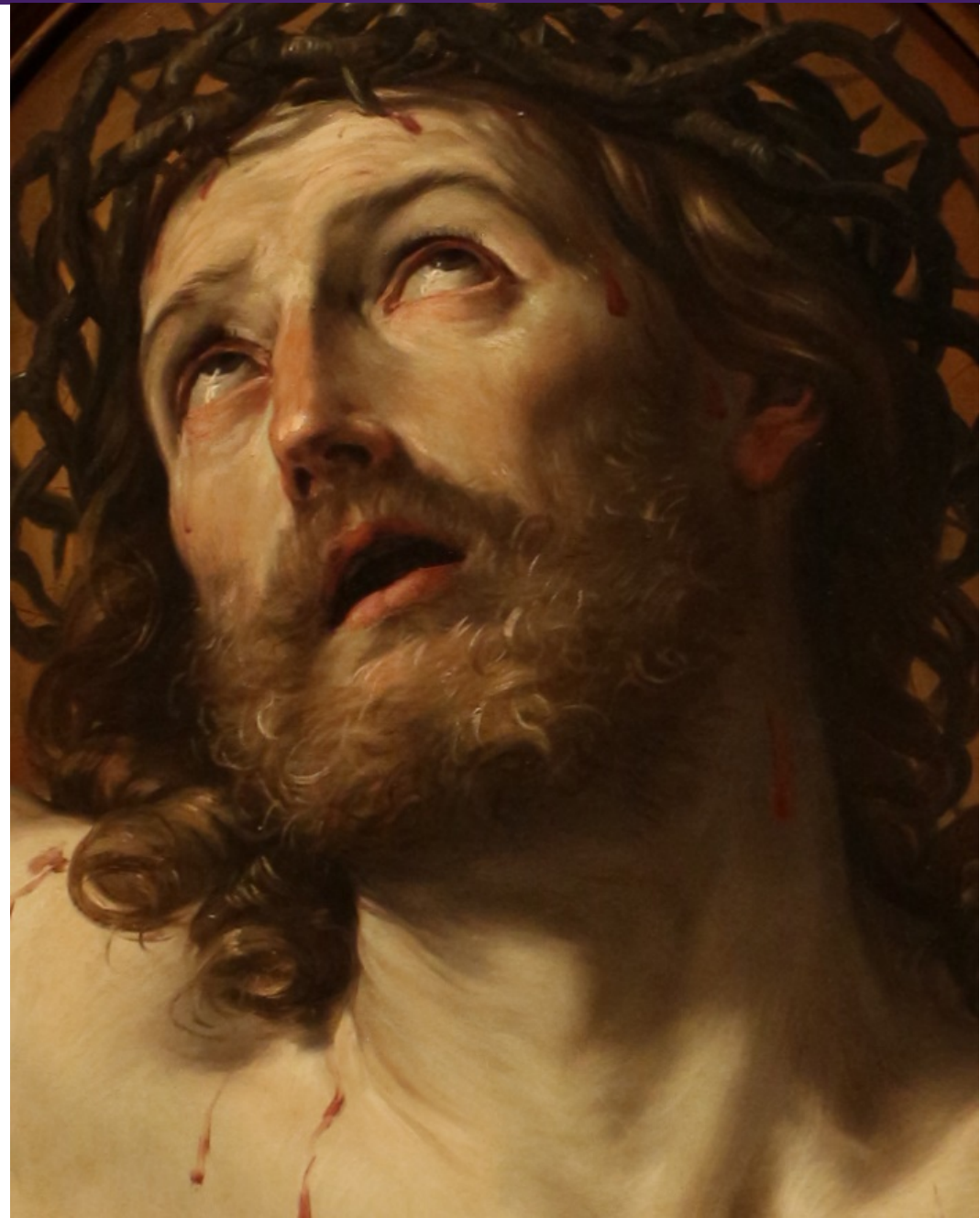

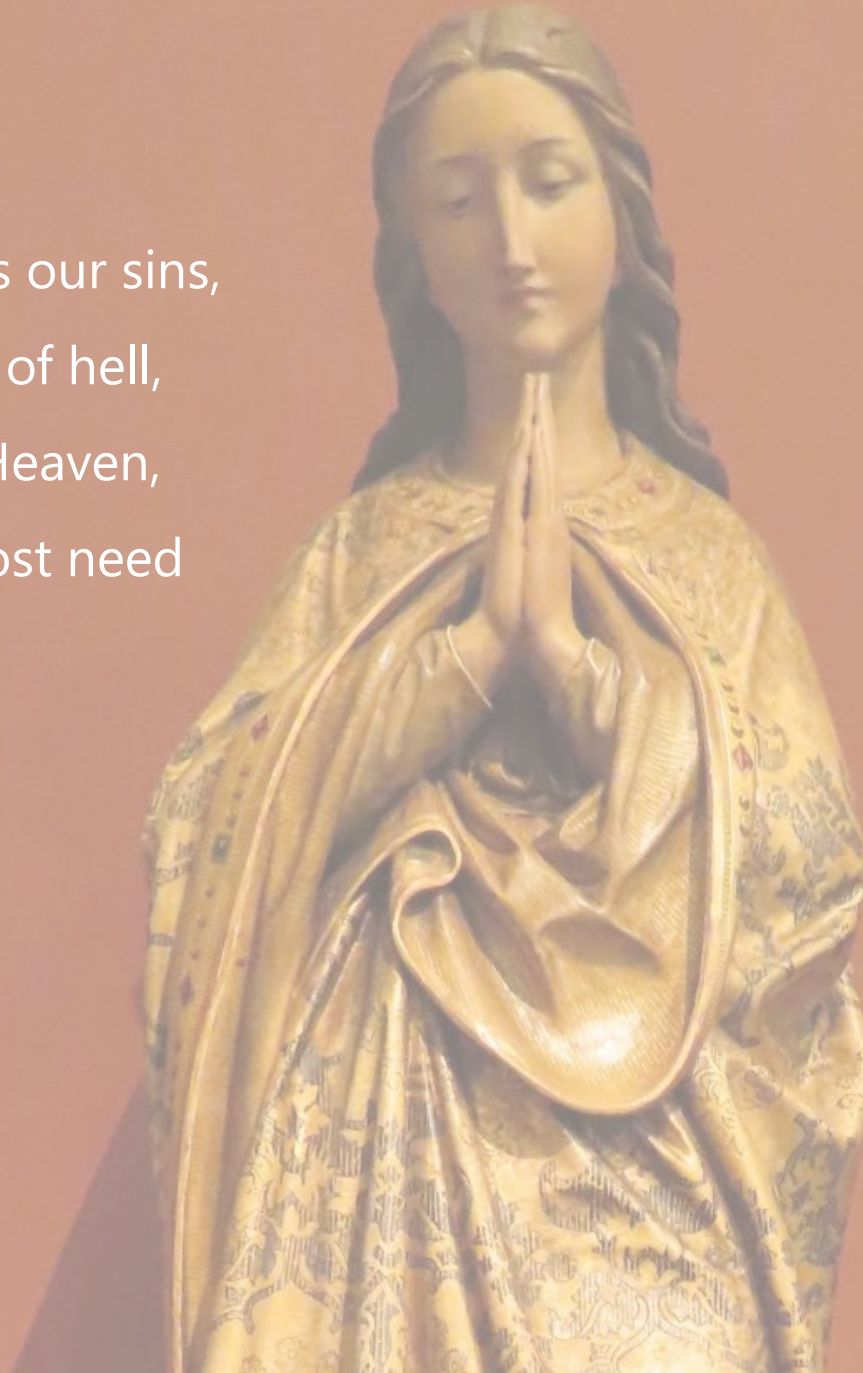
